INVESTMENT APPROACH

The Fundstrat Granny Shots US Small- & Mid-Cap ETF seeks long-term capital appreciation by investing primarily in US small- and mid-cap companies, generally those within the bottom 15% of the US equity market by market capitalization (up to approximately \$24.2 billion as of September 30, 2025).

Securities are selected through a top-down process of fundamental analysis and quantitative screening to identify companies that align with at least two of the research themes, including:

- Shorter-term themes (6–12 months): Style Tilt, Seasonality, and PMI Recovery
- Longer-term themes (3–6 years): Energy/Cyber Security, Millennials, Global Labor Suppliers, and Easing Financial Conditions

The portfolio is rebalanced quarterly with qualifying stocks given equal weighting and typically holds 20 to 100 positions.


